

## CENTERS OF TRAINING

This document highlights the requirements for being recognized as a Center of Training in Aesthetic Plastic Surgery by E(A)SAPS. This checklist can be sent out to national clinics, and the completed form should then be returned to the ESAPS secretary office.

### E(A)SAPS Center of Training in Aesthetic Plastic Surgery - Checklist

#### I. Facility Requirements:

- a.  At least one operating room available.
- b.  Compliance with European Society of Anaesthesiology standards.
- c.  Meets EU certification standards for operating rooms and medical units.
- d.  Adherence to national guidelines for equipment, unit construction, and ventilation (if applicable).

#### II. Medical Staff Requirements:

- a.  Specialist in Anaesthesiology available.
- b.  Trained nurses with expertise in Anaesthesiology.
- c.  Conducted risk analysis according to ASA CLASSIFICATION.
- d.  Specialist scrub nurses for instruments and sterility.
- e.  Trained recovery room staff.
- f.  Nurses with experience in Aesthetic Plastic Surgery for in-patient and out-patient care.
- g.  24/7 aftercare availability.

#### III. Competence of Plastic Surgeons:

- a.  Head of the unit is a board-certified Plastic Surgeon with a minimum of 5 years of experience.
- b.  Required memberships in National Society of Aesthetic Plastic Surgery and/or The National Society of Plastic Surgery and E(A)SAPS.
- c.  Detailed teaching abilities of the Plastic Surgeons.
- d.  Submission of CVs, list of publications, presentations, and specific procedures performed.

#### IV. Mono-topic Qualification:

- a.  Specialization in procedures such as breast surgery, rhinoplasty, body contouring, etc.
- b.  Minimum of 50 procedures per year.
- c.  At least 2 days of surgeries and a minimum of 4 surgeries per week.

#### V. General Qualification:

- a.  Ability to use English for teaching purposes.
- b.  Provision of theoretical education for a minimum of 2 hours per week.
- c.  Facilitation of trainees' attendance at various patient care stages.

**VI. Specific Qualification for Non-Surgical Rejuvenation:**

- a.  Certified medical doctors, preferably Dermatologists or Plastic Surgeons, for non-surgical procedures.
- b.  Supervision by an experienced Plastic Surgeon.
